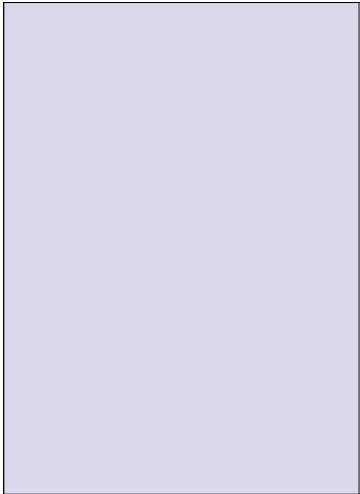

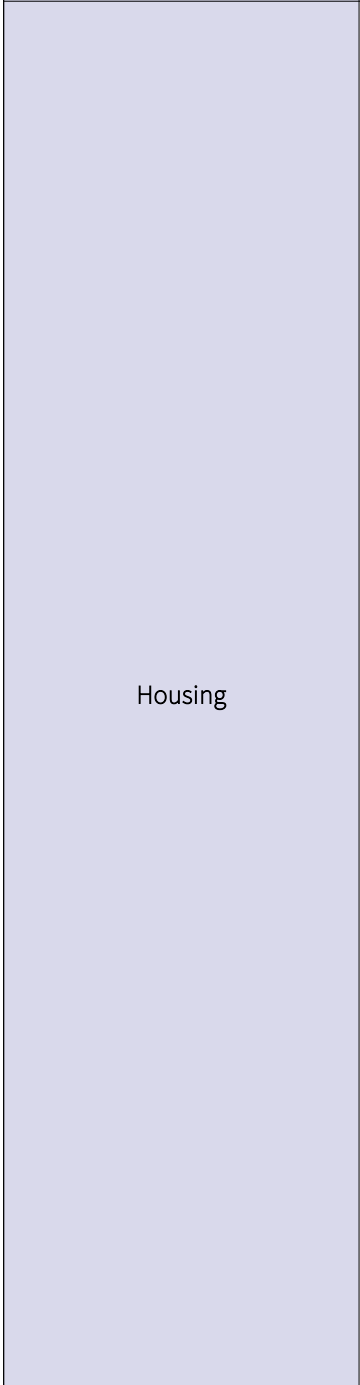

5. Student Life at Sungshin

Health Insurance	Private Health Insurance (Mandatory) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As required by the Korean Ministry of Education, you are required to be covered by Korean private health insurance. • For a one-time payment of around KRW 80,000, coverage is provided for six months (one semester). • The purpose of this private insurance is to cover medical gaps that may arise from the time you enter the country until your National Health Insurance coverage begins, which can take several months. • <u>The Certificate of Admission will be issued only after the payment has been confirmed.</u> Further details will be provided to students who have completed the application.
	National Health Insurance (Mandatory) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • National Health Insurance is mandated by the law. • National Health Insurance is applied upon the issuance of the Residence Card. • Details about registration and fees are TBA. • Fees must be paid on a monthly basis. (₩80,000–100,000 per month) • Students with Japanese or French nationality are eligible to apply for the exemption. (Students must apply for the exemption individually)

- After receiving the Certificate of Admission and the Business Registration Certificate from us via email, you can apply for a D-2 student visa at the Korean Embassy in your home country. Please contact the relevant diplomatic mission for specific procedures, required forms, and processing time, as they may vary by country.
- The D-2 student visa is valid for a single entry to Korea. **Without an ARC, you cannot re-enter Korea on the same student visa.** Be sure to obtain your ARC before departure during your exchange period.
- Please note that your D-2 visa will be used upon your first entry into Korea and will be invalidated when you depart from Korea in the absence of a valid Registration Card. Should you wish to go ahead with the above planned itinerary, you will need to apply for D-2 visa again for your exchange program.



Housing

- **Dormitory Accommodation:** Dormitory housing is available for international students.
- **Room Type:** Double Room / Triple Room / Quadruple Room (Room assignments may vary depending on the university’s circumstances.)
- **Location:** All dormitories are located within a 5–10 minute walking distance from campus.
- **Room Assignment:** **Rooms are randomly assigned** by the housing manager according to the number of students.
- **Application for Dormitory:** On your online application form, **select “Yes”** to reserve a spot in the dormitory.

 - Please exchange currency before arrival, as international transfers, ATMs, and card payments may not be reliable.
 - Failure to complete payment by the deadline may result in eviction from the dormitory.

Our exchange partners may nominate their students by email until given deadline. The nomination details need to include students full name, passport no., email address, period of study, academic major and intended field of study.

2. Application ※ Deadline: May 8th, 2026

After being nominated, our exchange partner will receive an email with attachments. The program coordinator should submit the following documents:

- Application Form
- Study Plan
- Copy of Passport
- Scanned Copy of Photo
- Certificate of Enrollment (Eng.)
- Transcript (Eng.)
- TOPIK Transcript(if students have)

Eligibility

Students nominees are required to meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled as a full-time student at one of our exchange partner universities
- Completed at least 1 semester at their home university
- Be in a good academic standing

3. Acceptance

The application screening process will be conducted at once after we receive all applications. Students can expect to receive a decision on their application within one month from application deadline. After being accepted, students will receive an acceptance package including official acceptance letter and certificate of admission for visa purposes.

4. Visa

Students may need to visit the Korean embassy or consulate in their home country to obtain a student Visa(D-2-6). Visa fees may apply.

5. Health Insurance

Students need to purchase health insurance in their home country or in Korea and must submit the certificate to the office (Mandatory). The insurance policy should cover sickness, accident and death.
