






Hanyang's progress is a reflection of Korea's development



Transportation Hub

Seoul is the nation's center of financial, political, commercial, recreational, and cultural affairs.






Stay at one of university-affiliated housings or live on your own!

- 2) Or purchase via Hanyang (Group rate: around 25,000 KRW)
- 3) This year, we strongly recommend students to purchase an insurance which also covers the medical fees for COVID-19.

- 1) Submit at least 2 weeks before the program
- 2) Or purchase via Hanyang HISS Team (Group rate: around CNY 150)

Visit near clinic/hospital and get medical services.





Easy and simple, all on-line!




Only students who have completed payment will be eligible for course registration. Please avoid last minute payments as they may take time to track.

Late-paying students may be required to email a bank transaction receipt to proceed to the next step.

VISA

K-ETA / C-3 Tourist Visa

- Students from a visa-waiver country need to apply for <u>K-ETA</u>(Korea Electronic Travel Authorization) prior to your boarding.
- Students from countries that are excluded from the Visa Waiver Agreement program must apply for a tourist visa (C-3).
- Students who wish to stay longer than your tourist visa expiry date may request for D-2-8 student visa.
