Health Insurance	Private Health Insurance (Mandatory) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As required by the Korean Ministry of Education, you are required to be covered by Korean private health insurance. • For a one-time payment of around KRW 80,000, coverage is provided for six months (one semester). • The purpose of this private insurance is to cover medical gaps that may arise from the time you enter the country until your National Health Insurance coverage begins, which can take several months. • <u>The Certificate of Admission will be issued only after the payment has been confirmed.</u> Further details will be provided to students who have completed the application.

Please contact the relevant diplomatic mission for specific procedures, required forms, and processing time, as they may vary by country.- The D-2 student visa is valid for a single entry to Korea. <u>Without an ARC, you cannot re-enter Korea on the same student visa.</u> Be sure to obtain your ARC before departure during your exchange period.- Please note that your D-2 visa will be used upon your first entry into Korea and will be invalidated when you depart from Korea in the absence of a valid Registration Card.
